Grant applications this year are due July 17, 2020. All applications must be post marked, emailed, or faxed stamped by the due date or they will be disqualified. The Grant Review Committee will consider each grant submitted. Grant awards will take place at the close of each annual conference. The Tenth Episcopal District's Web Site and TenthFuture, Inc. website provides access to an application packet that contains answers to questions such as: Who can apply? What information is needed? Who needs to sign? How to obtain an application and where do I send the completed application? What is TenthFuture, Inc.?

How to obtain the Grant Application?

- 3) You must have a PDF Viewer installed on your computer (such as the “Adobe Reader” available free at <http://www.adobe.com/reader> to view/print the application.

Who can apply for TenthFuture, Inc. Grants?

Proposals will be accepted from A.M.E. Churches in the 10th Episcopal District who demonstrate a plan or project with specific goals and a commitment to outreach, church growth, and community development.

What are examples of eligible types of activities for which the grant can be awarded?

Examples of eligible activities include:

- Utilizing technology to improve communication and visibility of the Tenth Episcopal District
- General Support – Property Improvement, Equipment Acquisition, Facility Repair
- Starting or developing new ministries to be relevant to the current Pandemic

What is the Application Deadline? July 17, 2020 by mail, fax, or hand delivered (if by postal mail, must be postmarked *no later than* deadline date), with all applicable signatures (Pastor & Presiding Elder).

What is the Maximum Grant Award? Up to \$1,000 for Churches

GUIDELINES FOR AME CHURCHES AND ORGANIZATIONS

All A.M.E. Churches in the 10th Episcopal District will need to complete this section of the application. Proposals must demonstrate a plan or project with specific goals and a commitment to outreach, church growth, and community development.

Deadline: July 17, 2020 Maximum Grant Request: Up to \$1,000.00

Review and Notification Process: All grant applications will be reviewed by the TenthFuture, Inc. Grant Review Committee prior to the start of the 2020 Annual Conference Series. Grant awards will be announced at the Annual Conference. Critiques of all proposals will be mailed at the end of all Annual Conferences

Directions for Completing the Grant Application:

Please use the following headings and respond completely to all parts of the question.

I. General Guidelines:

- The proposal is to be typed in 12-pt. Times New Roman.
- All text is double-spaced.
- All pages are to be numbered.
- All pages should have a 1"inch margin.
- Maximum number of pages is five (5).

II. Proposal Contents:

A. Grant Application Cover Sheet

B. Summary/description of the request. Attempt to address the following:

- What are the project goals and objectives?
- How will the church or organization accomplish these objectives?
- When will the objectives be achieved? Include a timetable and a work plan for the year the grant is being requested?
- Describe any recent activity, success or experiences in this area?
- What change will occur?

C. Evaluation Plan

- How will you know if this proposed project will be successful?
- What methods do you have or plan to put in place to measure and evaluate change?

D. Financial Information

- Prepare a detailed budget outlining how requested funds will be used.

E. Other Supporting Documents that will assist in understanding the proposal
